**SUBJECT:** Violation Hearing – Hashimi Enterprise, Inc. d/b/a 7-Eleven Express 625 W. Roosevelt Road

The Liquor Control Commission will convene a public hearing on May 12, 2022 to review evidence relating to allegations of a violation of the Liquor Control Ordinance by Hashimi Enterprise, Inc. d/b/a 7-Eleven Express whereby liquor was sold to a person under the age of 21.

In their witness of the liquor sale, the Wheaton Police observed that the sales clerk did not ask the decoy for identification.

Hashimi Enterprise, Inc. d/b/a 7-Eleven Express has entered a plea of guilty to the allegations.

This is Hashimi Enterprise, Inc. d/b/a 7-Eleven Express 1<sup>st</sup> violation of the Liquor Control Ordinance.
