SUBJECT: Violation Hearing – Whole Foods Market, 89 Danada Square East

The Liquor Control Commission will convene a continued public hearing on June 9, 2022 to review evidence relating to allegations of a violation of the Liquor Control Ordinance by Whole Foods Market, 89 Danada Square East whereby liquor was sold to a person under the age of 21.

In their witness of the liquor sale, the Wheaton Police observed that the sales clerk asked the decoy for identification.

Whole Foods Market, 89 Danada Square East has entered a plea of guilty to the allegations.

This is Whole Foods Market, 89 Danada Square East 2nd violation of the Liquor Control Ordinance; the first occurring in 2005 with a fine imposed of \$1,250.
