SUBJECT: Violation Hearing – Aadesh Corporation USA d/b/a Cigars & Cigarettes 628 W. Roosevelt Road

The Tobacco Control Commission will convene a public hearing on May 12, 2022 to review evidence relating to allegations of a violation of the Tobacco Control Ordinance by Aadesh Corporation USA d/b/a Cigars & Cigarettes 628 W. Roosevelt Road whereby tobacco products was sold to a person under the age of 21.

In their witness of the tobacco sale, the Wheaton Police observed that the sales clerk did not ask the decoy for identification.

Aadesh Corporation USA d/b/a Cigars & Cigarettes 628 W. Roosevelt Road has entered a plea of guilty to the allegations.

This is Aadesh Corporation USA d/b/a Cigars & Cigarettes 628 W. Roosevelt Road 4th violation of the Tobacco Control Ordinance, the 1st occurring in 2004 with a fine imposed of \$100; the 2nd occurring in 2005 with a fine imposed of \$250 and the 3rd occurring again in 2005 with a fine imposed of \$1,250 and a 5-day suspension.
