SUBJECT: Violation Hearing – Pharaoh’s Smoke Inc., 105 W. Geneva Road

The Tobacco Control Commission will convene a public hearing on May 12, 2022 to review evidence relating to allegations of a violation of the Tobacco Control Ordinance by Pharaoh’s Smoke Inc., 105 W. Geneva Road whereby tobacco products was sold to a person under the age of 21.

In their witness of the tobacco sale, the Wheaton Police observed that the sales clerk asked the decoy for identification.

Pharaoh’s Smoke Inc., 105 W. Geneva Road did not enter a plea to the allegations. The City Attorney has advised that the Tobacco Commission enter an order of default with respect to this matter.

This is Pharaoh’s Smoke Inc., 105 W. Geneva Road 1st violation of the Tobacco Control Ordinance.
