**SUBJECT:** Violation Hearing – South Main Marathon, 325 S. Main Street

The Tobacco Control Commission will convene a public hearing on May 12, 2022 to review evidence relating to allegations of a violation of the Tobacco Control Ordinance by South Main Marathon, 325 S. Main Street whereby tobacco products was sold to a person under the age of 21.

In their witness of the tobacco sale, the Wheaton Police observed that the sales clerk asked the decoy for identification.

South Main Marathon, 325 S. Main Street has entered a plea of guilty to the allegations.

This is South Main Marathon, 325 S. Main Street 4<sup>th</sup> violation of the Tobacco Control Ordinance, the 1<sup>st</sup> occurring in 2007 with a fine imposed of \$300; the 2<sup>nd</sup> occurring in 2012 with a fine imposed of \$500 and the 3<sup>rd</sup> occurring in 2018 with a fine imposed of \$500.
