

ORDINANCE NO. O-2022-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-89, "LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF LICENSES", OF ARTICLE III, "RETAIL LICENSES", OF CHAPTER 6, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES"

WHEREAS, the City restricts the number of retail liquor licenses in, Section 6-89 of Article III of the Wheaton City Code, by enumerating the number of licenses in the ordinance available for issuance per classification; and

WHEREAS, due to the timing of the granting or repeal of liquor licenses the codification of the City Code will frequently not reflect the accurate number of authorized liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the discrepancy between the number of licenses authorized by City Ordinance, and those expressed in the codification Section of 6-89 increases the possibility of confusion and error in the issuance or reduction in City liquor licenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule authority, that Section 6-89, "Limitation on Number of Licenses" of Article III, "Retail Licenses," of Chapter 6, "Alcoholic Beverages" of the Wheaton City Code, is hereby amended by repealing and rescinding Section 6-89 in its entirety and replacing it with a new Section 6-89, which shall be entitled "Limitation on Number of Licenses" which shall read:

SECTION 1: The number of liquor licenses authorized for each liquor license classification shall be limited to that number enumerated in the most recently adopted amendment to Section 6-89 "Limitation on the of Licenses", Article III, "Retail Licenses," of Chapter 6, "Alcoholic Beverages", on file with the City Clerk.

SECTION 2: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this amendment are repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
