**SUBJECT:** Reissuance of a Liquor License - The Lu's Inc. d/b/a Lu's Sushi and Chinese - 2001 S. Naperville Road

### **Request**

Consideration of a request to reissue a Liquor License to The Lu's Inc. d/b/a Lu's Sushi and Chinese, 2001 S. Naperville Road.

### **Background**

In February of this year, The Lu's Inc. d/b/a Lu's Sushi and Chinese, 2001 S. Naperville Road chose not to renew their Class A (Full Liquor) Liquor License as they have been open for carry-out only since the COVID pandemic began. Lu's has recently begun sit-down service in their restaurant and are asking for consideration of a request to reissue their Liquor License as a Class B (Beer and Wine Only).

### **Recommendation**

Lu's has been a liquor licensee in good standing since 2014. Subject to the applicant furnishing evidence satisfactory to the local liquor commissioner that such applicant is covered by a policy of liquor liability insurance as required by Section 6-93 of the City Code, Staff recommends that a Class B Liquor License be issued to The Lu's Inc. d/b/a/ Lu's Sushi and Chinese, 2001 S. Naperville Road.
