

RESOLUTION R-66-06

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WHEATON PUBLIC LIBRARY
CONSTRUCTION CHANGE IN SCOPE/MECHOSHADES AND ENHANCEMENT OF EAST
MAIN ENTRANCE LOBBY AREA**

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City") is an Illinois Home Rule Municipality pursuant to provisions of Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this resolution pertains to the government and affairs of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into an Agreement with Bulley & Andrews, LLC, for construction of an addition and renovation of the Wheaton Public Library ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Wheaton Library Staff and Architect for the Project, Burnidge and Cassell would like to recommend enhancements to the Project including the installation of Mechoshades as a window treatment for specified windows, and enhancement of the east main entrance lobby area to include the removal and replacement of entry sliding doors and hollow metal borrowed lites; and

WHEREAS, Bulley & Andrews, LLC, has provided Proposed Change Order No. 50 in the amount of \$20,406.00 to furnish and install the Mechoshades as more fully described therein and Change Order Request No. 64 in the amount of \$ 39,969.00 to enhance the east main entrance lobby area as more fully described in Constructive Change Directive No. 18 prepared by the architect, Burnidge Cassell Associates; and

WHEREAS, sufficient contingency funds are available to complete the enhancements to the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that Proposed Change Order No. 50 in the amount of \$20,406 and Change Order Request No. 64 in the amount of \$ 39,969.00 are approved
