

RESOLUTION R-25-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT EXTENSION WITH K.C.W. ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONING, INC. FOR CONTRACTUAL MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE FOR CITY HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City"), is an Illinois Home Rule Municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and as such, the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this resolution pertains to the government and affairs of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City had received a proposal from K.C.W. Environmental Conditioning, Inc. of Glen Ellyn, Illinois and in accordance with Paragraph 3 (Term of Agreement) of the Agreement Between the City and K.C.W., dated April 18, 2006, for Heating and Air Conditioning Maintenance the contract can be extended for the year May 1, 2007 through April 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City is satisfied with the quality and timeliness of the maintenance and repair service received from K.C.W. Environmental Conditioning, Inc.; and


WHEREAS, K.C.W. Environmental Conditioning, Inc. has agreed to hold firm their pricing and service agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City still has a need for such services and the Purchasing Officer recommends extending the agreement to cover the period May 1, 2007 through April 30, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that the Mayor is authorized to sign and the City Clerk is authorized to attest to an agreement extension between the City of Wheaton and K.C.W. Environmental Conditioning, Inc. of Glen Ellyn, Illinois for Heating and Air Conditioning Maintenance for the City.
