A RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING STRATEGIC ISSUES FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON

WHEREAS, the Wheaton City Council conducted a Strategic Planning Session on June 16, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City Council identified six strategic issues through the strategic planning process; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the focus of the City Council and the administrative staff of the City should be on these six strategic issues.


1. Pursue economic development (Theater, Roosevelt Road, Central Business District, other areas of the community).
2. Pursue infrastructure (storm water, sanitary sewer, sidewalks, street lighting, roads) improvement.
3. Pursue a pedestrian underpass in the Central Business District.
4. Pursue affordable housing options.
5. Pursue revenue enhancement options.
6. Pursue "green" policies.
