A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZNG PARTICIPATION BY THE CITY OF WHEATON IN THE PRESIDENT'S CITIZEN CORPS PROGRAM (THROUGH MILTON TOWNSHIP C.E.R.T.)

WHEREAS recent changes in the Department of Homeland Security, F.E.M.A. and I.E.M.A. regulations, as a condition to continued grant eligibility, require a local Citizen Corps to have a formal authorization from participating communities in the Citizen Corps Program; and


WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton has supported the efforts of the Milton Township Citizen Corps since its inception, and;


