

RESOLUTION R-18-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SOFTWARE SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WHEATON AND CDC CLOUD, INC. FOR 4GOV SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton, Illinois (the "City") is an Illinois home-rule municipality pursuant to provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power or perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this resolution pertains to the government and affairs of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department has been using the CDC Cloud, Inc. (previously Information Development Consultants) financial software for core business functions since 1991; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the Finance Department upgraded to their 4gov financial software and had entered into a four-year software service agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department would like to continue to use the CDC software and has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to enter into a two-year agreement with CDC Cloud, Inc. for the same monthly rate of \$5,690 as the previous agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the Software as a Service Agreement between the City of Wheaton and CDC Cloud, Inc.
