

ORDINANCE NO. F-0050

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 82, ARTICLE VI, OF THE
WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule power, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 82 (Vehicles For Hire), Article VI (Wrecker or Towing Service Businesses), is amended by the deletion of Section 82-188 (Termination of license) in its entirety and adding and including the following in lieu thereof:

"Sec. 82-188. Suspension/Termination of license.

Continued provision of services to the City of Wheaton by a licensed wrecker service is subject to compliance by the firm, its officers and its employees with all federal, state and municipal laws, ordinances and regulations including, but not limited to, criminal, environmental and zoning laws. Upon notification of an arrest for violation of any federal, state or municipal laws, the city manager may suspend any wrecker's license. The city manager may terminate any wrecker's license upon conviction for the violation of any federal, state or municipal law.

The City manager may also terminate any wrecker's license when he finds that:

- (1) The license was secured by fraud or by the concealment of a material fact by the wrecker owner and such fact, if known, would have caused a refusal to issue the license; or
- (2) The wrecker owner has violated any of the requirements or regulations contained in this article."

SECTION 2: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
