

ORDINANCE NO. F-0203

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
CITY OF WHEATON SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER FIVE
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 1997
AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1998

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois,
as follows:

Section 1: Findings. The City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Five has been created by an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Five", adopted October 6, 1997, and effective as of October 7, 1997, no valid petition having been filed opposing the creation of the special service area, pursuant to the Special Service Area Tax Act. Special Service Area Number Five consists of the territory described in the ordinance aforesaid. The City of Wheaton is now authorized to levy taxes for special services in said special service area.

Section 2: The following sums are hereby appropriated to pay the necessary expenses of Special Service Area Number Five for the fiscal period beginning May 1, 1997 and ending April 30, 1998, such appropriations being for the following objects and purposes:

Section 3: All ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
