ORDINANCE NO. F-0250

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON LIQUOR CONTROL
ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 6 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

WHEREAS, The City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City") is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power or perform any functions pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to consider certain amendments to the Wheaton Liquor Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Control Commission considered these amendments at its regular meeting on May 13, 1998, and the Liquor Control Commission has recommended approval of these amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: Section 6-87 is hereby amended by adding the following:

"(18) Class O license shall authorize the manufacture of beer, only at a designated premises, for the sole purpose of the retail sale, consumption and storage of such beer only at and within such premises.

- a. A class O license shall only be available as a supplemental license for premises holding a class I license.
- b. All such supplemental licenses shall be granted only upon a showing by the applicant that all applicable Federal and State tax stamps have been procured."

Section 2: Section 6-88 is hereby amended by adding the following:

"O \$500.00"

Section 3: Section 6-129 is hereby amended as follows:


"(4) K	Monday - Saturday	11:00 a.m. - 12:00 midnight

12:00 noon - 12:00 midnight"


Section 4: All ordinances, or parts of other ordinances, in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
