

ORDINANCE NO. F-0261

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRONT YARD VARIATION ON A CERTAIN
PIECE OF PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS
219 NORTH ELLIS AVENUE - MCGRATH**

WHEREAS, written application has been made requesting a variation from the provisions of the City of Wheaton Zoning Ordinance in order to reduce the front yard setback from 30 feet to 10 feet to allow the construction of a covered front porch onto an existing home on a certain piece of property legally described herein and commonly known as 219 North Ellis Avenue, Wheaton, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice as required by the Illinois Municipal Code and the Wheaton Zoning Ordinance, a public hearing was conducted by the Wheaton Board of Zoning Appeals on July 14, 1998, to consider the variation request and the Wheaton Board of Zoning Appeals has unanimously recommended approval of the zoning variation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to the Findings of Fact determined by the Wheaton Board of Zoning Appeals, a variation from Article 10.2.5 of the Wheaton Zoning Ordinance is granted to permit a covered front porch in compliance with the porch plans entitled "*219 North Ellis Avenue*".

The property that is subject of the variation is legally described as:

THE SOUTH 50.0 FEET OF LOT 5 IN BLOCK 5 OF COUNTY CLERK'S ASSESSMENT
DIVISION OF THE SOUTH HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER AND THE
SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 17, AND THE NORTH 10 CHAINS OF THE
NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST OF
THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS
P.I.N. 05-17-231-002

The property is commonly known as 219 North Ellis Avenue, Wheaton, Illinois 60187.


Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.
