

ORDINANCE NO. F-0275
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE III,
"WHEATON LIQUOR ORDINANCE", OF THE CITY CODE
(DECREASE IN CLASS I LICENSE/APPLEBEE'S)

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule power, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 6, Article III, of the Wheaton City Code is amended by the deletion of Section 6-89 in its entirety and adding and including the following in lieu thereof:

"Limitation on number of licenses. The number of licenses in each classification as defined in Section 6-87 which it shall be lawful to issue shall be limited so that the licenses in force and effect in the City at any time shall not exceed the following numbers:

SECTION 2: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
