

ORDINANCE NO. F-0325
AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SIDE YARD VARIATION
ON A CERTAIN PIECE OF PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS
1862 WINGATE LANE- DIERKING

WHEREAS, written application has been made requesting a variation from the Zoning Ordinance to allow the construction of a one-story addition with a walkout basement on an existing home with a side yard of 12.25 feet in lieu of 14.67 feet on a certain piece of property legally described herein and commonly known as 1862 Wingate Lane, Wheaton, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice as required by the Illinois Municipal Code and the Wheaton Zoning Ordinance, a public hearing was conducted by the Wheaton Board of Zoning Appeals on March 9, 1999, to consider the variation request and the Wheaton Board of Zoning Appeals has unanimously recommended approval of the zoning variation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to the Findings of Fact determined by the Wheaton Board of Zoning Appeals, a variation is granted to allow the construction of a one-story addition with a walkout basement on an existing home with a side yard of 12.25 feet in lieu of 14.67 feet in full compliance with the plans entitled "*Site Plan, Dierking Residence, 1862 Wingate Lane, Wheaton, IL 60187, prepared by Waterman Bros. Construction, Inc., 101 Bridge Street, Wheaton, IL.*"

The property that is subject of the variation is legally described as:

LOT 16 IN JOE KEIM'S ARROWHEAD UNIT NO. 6, A SUBDIVISION IN THE WEST HALF OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED DECEMBER 15, 1977, AS DOCUMENT R77-116127, IN THE CITY OF WHEATON, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS. P.I.N. 05-30-106-020.

The property is commonly known as 1862 Wingate Lane, Wheaton, Illinois 60187.


Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.
