

ORDINANCE NO. F-0337

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 26 (BUSINESSES),
ARTICLE III (BURGLAR AND HOLDUP ALARM BUSINESSES),
OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, pursuant to home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 26 (Businesses), Article III (Burglar and Holdup Alarm Businesses), of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, is hereby further amended by deleting and replacing subparagraph (b) of Section 26-84 (Penalties; hearing.) with the following:

“(b) All fines shall be paid to the city finance department within 30 days from the date of the invoice requesting payment of the fine(s). Any alarm user who fails to pay any fines or charges provided for under this Section within 30 days from the date of the invoice requesting payment of same shall be subject to revocation of alarm user permit. Any such alarm user permit shall not be reinstated until all the unpaid fines and fees are paid in full.”

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
