

ORDINANCE NO. F-0396

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL MOTOR
VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC SCHEDULES (CHAPTER 70)
FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON, ILLINOIS
(NO PARKING)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VII.(Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets) as referred in Section 70-354(d) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (20) Parking prohibited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday except legal holidays.

(a) Morse Street - west side - from the school parking lot to approximately 550 feet north thereof.

SECTION 2: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII.(Parking time (nonmetered) limited on certain streets and off-street lots), as referred in Section 70-354(e) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

- (a) 4-hour limit:
(35) University Place- North side from President Street to Webster Avenue;
south side from Webster Avenue to Howard Street.

SECTION 3: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VI. (Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets), as referred in Section 70-354(c) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

- (6) University Place - North side from Howard Street to Webster Avenue; south side Webster Avenue to President Street.

SECTION 4: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage approval and publication in a manner provided by law.
