

## ORDINANCE NO. F-0535

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74 (UTILITIES), DIVISION 2 (FEES) AND APPENDIX B (FEE SCHEDULE) OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Section 74 (Utilities), Division 2 (Fees), Section 74-166 (Schedule of fees for connection to water-sewer system), subparagraphs (3) (a) (1) and (3) (a) (2) only of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, are hereby deleted in their entirety and replaced as follows:

*“(3) Tap fees.*

*a. Water main taps.*

1. One-inch through two-inch water main taps made by the city shall include labor, equipment rental and materials, and shall be as follows:
  - i. One-inch tap. . . . \$ 1,250.00
  - ii. One-and one-half-inch tap. . . . 1,400.00
  - iii. Two-inch tap. . . . 1,550.00
  - iv. The fee for abandoning and plugging of each unused water service shall be. . . . 300.00
2. All four-inch through eight-inch water main taps shall be made by the city. Fees for these taps shall include labor and equipment rental for a maximum of three hours. Such fees shall exclude tapping valve, valve box, sleeve, excavation, backfill and restoration.
  - i. Four-inch tap. . . . \$ 250.00
  - ii. Six-inch tap. . . . 275.00
  - iii. Eight-inch tap . . . . 300.00
  - iv. Over three hours labor, per hour. . . . 30.00"

Section 2: That Section 74 (Utilities), Division 2 (Fees), Section 74-177 (Installation charge), of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

**“Sec. 74-177. Installation charge.**

Original small water meter installations with the exclusion of the piping shall be performed by the city water division. The charge for installation, including labor, meter equipment and the remote readout device, shall be in accordance with the

following schedule of fees:

Five-eighths-inch. . . . .	\$ 170.00
Three-fourths-inch. . . . .	190.00
One-inch. . . . .	230.00
One and one-half inch. . . . .	470.00
Two-inch. . . . .	590.00

Charges for plumber installation of larger meters shall be the cost of the meter plus a ten percent handling fee."

Section 3: That Appendix B (Fee Schedule), Section B-22 (Water fees), Paragraph (7) "For the sale of water meters", subparagraphs (a) through (f), of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, are hereby deleted in their entirety and replaced as follows:

"(7) For the sale of water meters:

(a) 5/8-inch meter. . . . .	\$ 170.00
(b) 3/4-inch meter. . . . .	190.00
(c) 1-inch meter. . . . .	230.00
(d) 1 1/2-inch meter. . . . .	470.00
(e) 2-inch meter (Disc) .	590.00
(f) For plumber installation of larger meter, cost of meter plus ten percent handling fee"	

Section 4: That Appendix B (Fee Schedule), Section B-22 (Water fees), Paragraph (8) "Water taps", subparagraphs (a) and (b) only, of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, are hereby deleted in their entirety and replaced as follows:

"(a) Taps for water service, including labor, equipment rental and materials for tap and service installation to and including shutoff valve:	
1. 1-inch tap. . . . .	\$ 1,250.00
2. 1 1/2-inch tap. . . . .	1,400.00
3. 2-inch tap. . . . .	1,550.00
4. Fee for abandoning and plugging each unused water service shall be. . . . .	300.00
(b) Taps for water service, including labor and equipment rental; excludes tapping valve, valve box, sleeve, excavation, backfill and restoration. Fee for maximum of three hours labor:	
1. 4-inch tap. . . . .	\$ 250.00
2. 6-inch tap. . . . .	275.00

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3. 8-inch tap. . . . .	300.00
4. Over three hours labor, per hour. . . . .	30.00"

Section 5: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6: That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in a manner provided by law.
