**ORDINANCE NO. F-0557**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 30, ARTICLE V  
FOREIGN FIRE INSURANCE TAX BOARD OF THE  
WHEATON CITY CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: That Section 30-102 Powers, duties, procedures, paragraph (1) of Chapter 30, Article V Foreign Fire Insurance Tax Board, is hereby repealed and rescinded in its entirety and replaced with a Section 30-102 paragraph (1) entitled Powers, duties, procedures which shall read:

- (1) By December 1<sup>st</sup> of each year the officers of the Board shall approve a preliminary budget for the expenditure of the funds received pursuant to the foreign fire insurance tax. The officers of the Board shall, no later than February 1<sup>st</sup>, adopt a final budget for the collection and expenditure of the foreign fire insurance tax; the budget shall be subject to the approval of the City Council. The final budget may be amended at any time by a majority vote of the officers of the Board; any amendment shall be subject to approval of the City Council. Expenditures shall be made only for items specifically described in the final budget as originally adopted or subsequently amended by the Board and approved by the City Council.

Section 2: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
