

ORDINANCE NO. F-0600

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON ZONING ORDINANCE MAP
ON A CERTAIN PIECE OF PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS
1807 GARY AVENUE/MUEHLFELT

WHEREAS, a written application has been made to amend the Zoning Map, which is attached to and forms a part of the Zoning Ordinance of Wheaton, Illinois, to rezone and reclassify certain property legally described herein within the city limits of Wheaton, Illinois ("City"), and commonly located at 1807 North Gary Avenue, Wheaton, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the zoning application is being requested pursuant to the terms and conditions of a certain annexation agreement dated June 4, 2001, among the City and Harold J. Muehlfelt and Lois Muehlfelt ("Owners") ("Annexation Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice as required by the Illinois Municipal Code and the Wheaton Zoning Ordinance, a public hearing was conducted by the Wheaton City Council, sitting as a special hearing body on May 14, 2001, to consider the requested zoning amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Du Page County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: The Zoning map, which is attached to and forms a part of the Wheaton Zoning Ordinance, is amended by adding, including and classifying the following described property in the R-3 Residential District zoning classification:

THE NORTH 88 FEET OF THE SOUTH 209 FEET OF THE WEST 220 FEET OF LOT 2 IN MUEHLFELT'S FIRST SUBDIVISION OF A PART OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 39, NORTH, RANGE 10, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED NOVEMBER 12, 1947 AS DOCUMENT 533909, IN DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

This property is commonly known as 1807 North Gary Avenue, Wheaton, Illinois 60187.

Section 2: The subject property shall be developed and improved in full compliance with the terms, provisions, and conditions of the Annexation Agreement; and the zoning granted

herein is granted pursuant to the Annexation Agreement, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk and incorporated into this ordinance by this reference as though fully set forth herein.


Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.
