

ORDINANCE NO. F-0975**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF
TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2004
AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2005, IN AND FOR
THE CITY OF WHEATON SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER SIX**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Findings. The City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Six has been created by an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Six", adopted November 1, 2004, and effective as of November 2, 2004, no valid petition having been filed opposing the creation of the special service area, pursuant to Public Act 88-455. Special Service Area Number Six consists of the territory described in the ordinance aforesaid. The City of Wheaton is authorized to levy taxes for special services in Special Service Area Number Six.

Section 2: The total amount of appropriations for all the purposes to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year in Special Service Area Number Six is ascertained to be the sum of \$187,687.

Section 3: The following sums shall be levied upon the taxable property as defined in the Public Act 88-455, in the City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Six; said tax to be levied for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2004, and ending April 30, 2005.

Administration and Related Expenses	\$140,000
Promotion and Related Expenses	<u>47,687</u>

Section 4: This tax is levied pursuant to Public Act 88-455 and pursuant to An Ordinance Establishing City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Six.

Section 5: The \$187,687 tax levy is certified to the County Clerk of DuPage County, Illinois. The City of Wheaton determines this \$187,687 tax levy to be the total amount required to be raised by taxation for the current fiscal year of the City for Special Service Area Number Six. The City Clerk of Wheaton, Illinois, is ordered and directed to file with the County Clerk of DuPage County, on or before the time required by law, a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

Section 7: This ordinance shall become effective from or after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
