ORDINANCE NO. F-1085

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 (ADMINISTRATION),
OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule power, as follows:


Section 1: That Chapter 2, Article IX Finance, Section 2-564. Depositories for funds designated, paragraph (a) be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with the following:

JP Morgan Chase Bank N.A., Wheaton, Illinois; J.P. Morgan Trust N.A., Columbus, Ohio; Fifth Third Bank, Wheaton, Illinois; J.P. Morgan Asset Management, Boston, Massachusetts; LaSalle Bank N.A., Chicago, Illinois; **MidAmerica Bank, Wheaton, Illinois**; The Illinois Funds (US Bank), Springfield, Illinois; American Freedom Funds (State Street Bank and Trust Co.), Boston Massachusetts; Citibank N.A., New Castle, Delaware, are hereby designated as depositories in which the funds of this city may be deposited by its officers, agents and employees, and each of them hereby is authorized to endorse for deposit or negotiation any and all checks, drafts, notes, bills of exchange, and order for the payment of money either belonging to or coming into the possession of this city. Endorsements for deposit may be made by the written or stamped endorsement of the city without designation of the person making the endorsement.

Section 2: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.


Section 4: That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, in the manner prescribed by law.
