

ORDINANCE NO. F-1224

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON LIQUOR CONTROL
ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 6 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

WHEREAS, The City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City") is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power or perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to consider certain amendments to the Wheaton Liquor Control Ordinance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: That in Sec. 6-130, "Same-Extended Hours." is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:


"Sec. 6-130. Same—Extended hours.

Any licensee holding a liquor license may request to extend their liquor license hours three days per calendar year. A written request shall be submitted to the local liquor commissioner not less than 30 days prior to the dates for which permission is sought. The local liquor commissioner shall place any condition, restriction, and limitation on said extension as deemed necessary."

Section 2: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
