ORDINANCE NO. F-1318

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER TWO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2007 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2008

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Findings. The City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Two has been created by an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing the Wheaton Special Service Area Number Two", adopted February 8, 1983, and effective as of February 9, 1983, no petition having been filed opposing the creation of the special service area, pursuant to Public Act 88-455. Special Service Area Number Two consists of the territory described in the ordinance aforesaid. The City of Wheaton is now authorized to levy taxes for special services in said special service area.

Section 2: The following sums are hereby appropriated to pay the necessary expenses of Special Service Area Number Two for the fiscal period beginning May 1, 2007 and ending April 30, 2008, such appropriations being for the following objects and purposes:




Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.
