

## ORDINANCE NO. F-1329

### **AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF TIME ON THE VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE NO. F-1181 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON ZONING MAP AND GRANTING VARIATIONS – 222 W. ROOSEVELT ROAD/PASAVENTO**

**WHEREAS**, on June 19, 2006 the Mayor and City Council approved F-1181 (Original Ordinance) which granted a zoning change and variations to allow the redevelopment of the property at 222 W. Roosevelt Road into a two story office building and associated parking; and

**WHEREAS**, Article 4.4 of the City of Wheaton Zoning Ordinance provides that upon written application and for good cause shown, the corporate authorities may, in their sole discretion, authorize the extension of the validity of an ordinance granting a variation on a certain piece of property; and

**WHEREAS**, the owner of the subject property has requested an extension of time on the validity of the Original Ordinance.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Du Page County, Illinois, that an extension is granted to allow the Original Ordinance to be valid until June 19, 2008.

The property that is subject of the variation extension is legally described as:

LOT 5 IN BLOCK 4 (EXCEPT THE NORTH 10 FEET TAKEN FOR ROOSEVELT ROAD) IN WASHINGTON WHEATON SUBDIVISION UNIT NO. FOUR, BEING A SUBDIVISION IN SECTIONS 20 AND 21, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 10, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED FEBRUARY 10, 1947 AS DOCUMENT 515568, IN DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.


