

ORDINANCE NO. F-1563

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION," ARTICLE III, "OFFICERS," DIVISION 2 "MAYOR" OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule power, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 2, Administration, Division 3 Mayor, Section 2-127 "Emergency powers and duties," subparagraph (f), of the Wheaton City Code, 1990 as amended, is hereby amended repealed and rescinded in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 2-127, subparagraph (f) as follows:

"(f) Effective period of declaration; council determination as to whether emergency still exists. The declaration authorized by this section shall be effective for seven (7) days (20 ILCS 3305/11), at which time the city council shall meet in regular or special session to determine whether or not the state of emergency still exists. If, in the opinion of the majority of the city council, the emergency still exists, the declaration and any order of the mayor shall continue in effect until the next regular meeting of the city council, unless terminated by a majority vote at a special meeting called for such purpose. Such declaration shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven (7) days except by or with the consent of the governing board of the political subdivision.


SECTION 2: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
