

ORDINANCE NO. F- 1733

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 6 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES EMPLOYMENT OF UNDERAGED PERSONS

WHEREAS, The City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City") is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power or perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to consider certain amendments to the Wheaton Liquor Control Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:


Section 1: That Sec. 6-127, subsection (a) is hereby repealed and rescinded in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 6-127 subsection (a) which shall read as follows:

"Sec. 6-127. - Employment of underaged persons.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any licensee, under this chapter, or any officer, associate, member, representative, agent, or employee of such licensee, to engage, employ or permit any person under the age of 21 years to attend bar or to draw, pour, or mix any alcoholic liquor in any licensed premises; provided, that the provisions of this section shall not be construed to prevent the employment of persons who are at least 18 years of age as waiters or waitresses in restaurants or hotels for the purpose of taking orders, serving food and alcoholic liquor in the licensed retail premises."

Section 2: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
