

ORDINANCE NO. F-1804

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 6 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – RESTRICTIONS TO ISSUANCE

WHEREAS, The City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City") is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power or perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to consider certain amendments to the Wheaton Liquor Control Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: That Sec. 6-85, subsection (b) is hereby repealed and rescinded in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 6-85 subsection (b) which shall read as follows:

"(b) *No liquor license shall be issued for the sale at retail of any alcoholic liquor within 100 feet of any church, school, hospital, home for the aged or indigent persons. The distance of 100 feet shall be measured between the nearest parts of any such building and the building which is the subject of any application for a liquor license, provided that this prohibition shall not apply to places of business where the sale of alcoholic liquors is not the principal business carried on."*


Section 2: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
