

ORDINANCE NO. F-1811

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 42 “OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS,” ARTICLE I “IN GENERAL,” SECTION 42-28 “FIREWORKS” OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:


Section 1: That Chapter 42 “Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions,” Article I “In General,” Section 42-28 (d) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, is hereby repealed and rescinded in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 42-28. Fireworks.

(d) Applications for a permit to exhibit fireworks shall be made in writing at least 30 days in advance of the date of the date of the display. The fee for such permit shall be \$50.00 if such privilege shall be granted. The sale, possession, use and distribution of fireworks for such display shall be lawful for the purpose stated in this article only. No permit granted hereunder shall be transferable.


Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
