

## ORDINANCE NO. F-1990

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26-83(a) OF SECTION 26-83 "TRANSMISSION OF EXCESSIVE FALSE ALARMS, GROUNDS FOR REVOCATION OF PERMIT" OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

**WHEREAS**, a Code review of Section 26-83(a) of Chapter 26 of the Wheaton City Code by Wheaton staff revealed an ambiguity between Section 26-83(a) and Section 26-84(a)(1) of the Wheaton City Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the City of Wheaton have deemed it appropriate to resolve the ambiguity.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:


**SECTION 1:** Section (a), of Section 26-83, "Transmission of Excessive False Alarms, Grounds for revocation of permit," Chapter 26 "Businesses," of the Wheaton City Code, is hereby repealed and rescinded in its entirety and replaced with a new Subsection (a), which shall read as follows:

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to transmit more than three (3) false fire alarms within any calendar year from any single alarm system.

**SECTION 2:** If a court of competent jurisdiction sets aside any portion of this Ordinance as unconstitutional or unlawful, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** Any ordinance which is inconsistent with this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage, execution by the Mayor and publication as required by law.
