

ORDINANCE NO. F-2039

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL MOTOR VEHICLE
AND TRAFFIC SCHEDULES (CHAPTER 70)
FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON
Parking Restrictions

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking time (non-metered) limited on certain streets and off-street lots), section III, paragraph (a) as referred in Section 70-354 of the Wheaton City Code, 2017, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting Subparagraph (15) in its entirety.

SECTION 2: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking time (non-metered) limited on certain streets and off-street lots), section I, paragraph (a) as referred in Section 70-354 of the Wheaton City Code, 2017, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting Subparagraph (11) in its entirety and replacing it to read as follows:

(11) Liberty Drive North side – from Bridge Street to Commerce Drive and from Williston Street (north) to Williston Street (south). Both sides – from Williston Street (north) to Summit Street.

SECTION 3: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking time (non-metered) limited on certain streets and off-street lots), section I, paragraph (a) as referred in Section 70-354 of the Wheaton City Code, 2017, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting Subparagraph (30) in its entirety and replacing it to read as follows:

(30) Williston Street Both sides from Avery Avenue to Willow Avenue.

SECTION 4: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking time (non-metered) limited on certain streets and off-street lots), section I, paragraph (a) as referred in Section 70-354 of the Wheaton City Code, 2017, as amended, is hereby amended by adding Subparagraph (34) to read as follows:

(34) Crescent Street Both sides from Chase Street to Sumner Street.

SECTION 5: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: That this Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication provided by law.
