**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY AGREEMENT AMENDMENT  
WITH THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FEDERAL PARTICIPATION IN THE  
BLANCHARD STREET/PRESIDENT STREET RESURFACING PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois and the State of Illinois Department of Transportation jointly propose to resurface FAU Route 2567 known locally as Blanchard Street between Tara Court and President Street and FAU Route 2569 known locally as President Street between Blanchard Road and Route 38 in Wheaton, Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and State have entered into an agreement to receive Federal fund participation for the construction costs of the subject project; and

**WHEREAS**, additional funds have been allocated to the project due to higher costs received through bidding, and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the City and State to enter into an amendment to the agreement to receive the additional Federal fund participation for the construction costs of the subject project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that the Mayor is authorized to execute a Local Public Agency Agreement Amendment with the Illinois Department of Transportation for Federal participation in construction of the resurfacing of Blanchard Street (FAU Route 2567) and President Street (FAU Route 2569), Project No. BDF3(494), Job No. C-91-146-18, Section 18-00119-00-RS.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City authorizes the expenditure of Two Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-six and no/100 Dollars (\$276,826.00), or as much may be needed to match federal funds in completion of the subject project.


