

RESOLUTION R-2019-55

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THERMOPLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING SERVICES FROM SUPERIOR ROAD STRIPING, INC. THROUGH THE JOINT PURCHASING PROGRAM WITH DUPAGE COUNTY FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Governmental Joint Purchasing Act (30 ILCS 525/1, et seq.), the City may purchase personal property, supplies, and services joining with other governmental units; and Illinois State Statutes authorize municipal governments to jointly purchase supplies; and

WHEREAS, the DuPage County ("County") Cooperative has publicly and competitively bid for Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Services; and

WHEREAS, the County awarded a contract to Superior Road Striping, Inc. in Melrose Park, Illinois, for Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Services and has made the County contract available to other public entities; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that the contract with Superior Road Striping, Inc. through the County's Cooperative contract meets the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton find it reasonable, appropriate and necessary to purchase Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Services from Superior Road Striping, Inc. through the County's Cooperative contract, for the Street Division of the Public Works Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

- a) City Agreement #74 for the purchase of Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Services from Superior Road Striping, Inc. of Melrose Park, Illinois, through the DuPage County cooperative contract #19-PVMKG-07-GM for the Street Division of the Public Works Department for a total amount not to exceed \$60,000 for one (1) year is hereby authorized (the "Purchase");
- b) City staff is authorized to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction.
