

RESOLUTION R-2020-28

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A SUBSCRIPTION OF CROWDSTRIKE FALCON COMPLETE ENDPOINT PROTECTION FROM CDW GOVERNMENT, LLC. FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$48,565**

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into a purchase agreement with CDW Governmental, LLC, located in Vernon Hills, Illinois, for the purchase of a one year subscription of CrowdStrike Falcon Complete Endpoint Protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City issued a Request for Quote package (RFQ Number 20-31) to CrowdStrike authorized vendors, and CDW Governmental, LLC., submitted a quote in the amount of \$48,565; and

**WHEREAS**, the City budgeted funds in the General Fund, Information Technology-Software Licenses/Maintenance account in the amount of \$53,807.00; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties agree to the terms and conditions and pricing set forth in the quotation for a subscription of CrowdStrike Falcon Complete Endpoint Protection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The City's Purchase Order #2021034 for the purchase of a one year subscription of CrowdStrike Falcon Complete Endpoint Protection from CDW Governmental, LLC., 75 Remittance Drive, Suite 1515, Chicago, Illinois, 60675, for a total amount not to exceed \$48,565, is hereby authorized (the "Purchase") and City staff is authorized to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction. A copy of the City's Purchase Order #2021034 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-28 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.
