

RESOLUTION R-2020-23

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF UPM COLD PATCH FROM
SUPERIOR ASPHALT MATERIALS, LLC., FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into a purchase agreement with Superior Asphalt Materials, LLC., 216 E. Butterfield Road, North Aurora, Illinois, 60542, for the purchase of UPM Cold Patch; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 20-12) that included UPM Cold Patch; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on March 2, 2020, at 11:00AM and Superior Asphalt Materials, LLC., was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in multiple accounts in the amount of \$20,000 for UPM Cold Patch; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions and pricing set forth in the bid proposal for UPM Cold Patch.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The City's Purchase Order #2021033 for the purchase of UPM Cold Patch from Superior Asphalt Materials, LLC., 216 E. Butterfield Road, North Aurora, Illinois, 60542, for a total amount not to exceed \$20,000, is hereby authorized (the "Purchase") and City staff is authorized to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction. A copy of the City's Purchase Order #2021033 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-23 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.
