

RESOLUTION R-2020-24

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BITUMINOUS MATERIAL
FROM PLOTE CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$424,525**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into a purchase agreement with Plete Construction, Inc., 1100 Brandt Dr., Hoffman Estates, Illinois, 60192, for the purchase of Bituminous Material; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 20-12) that included Bituminous Material; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on March 2, 2020, at 11:00AM and Plete Construction, Inc. was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in multiple accounts in the amount of \$424,525 for Bituminous Material; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions and pricing set forth in the bid proposal for Bituminous Material.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:


The City's Purchase Order #2021032 for the purchase of Bituminous Material from Plete Construction, Inc., 1100 Brandt Dr., Hoffman Estates, Illinois, 60192, for a total amount not to exceed \$424,525, for the Public Works Department is hereby authorized (the "Purchase") and City staff is authorized to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction.
