

ORDINANCE NO. O-2020-40

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 6,  
ARTICLE III OF THE CITY CODE - INCREASE IN CLASS I (RESTAURANTS) LIQUOR LICENSE  
EMC EATERY, INC., DBA WHEATON HOUSE - 133 W. FRONT STREET**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule power, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 6, Article III, of the Wheaton City Code is amended by repealing and rescinding Section 6-89 in its entirety and replacing it with a new Section 6-89 which shall read as follows:

**Limitation on number of licenses.** The number of licenses in each classification as defined in Section 6-87 which it shall be lawful to issue shall be limited so that the licenses in force and effect in the City at any time shall not exceed the following numbers:

SECTION 2: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
