

RESOLUTION R-2021-10

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BITUMINOUS MATERIAL
FROM PLOTE CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$424,450**

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 21-13) that included Bituminous Material; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on February 17, 2021, at 11:00 AM and Plete Construction, Inc. was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in multiple accounts in the amount of \$424,450 for Bituminous Material; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions and pricing set forth in the bid proposal for Bituminous Material; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into a purchase order agreement with Plete Construction, Inc., 1100 Brandt Dr., Hoffman Estates, Illinois, 60192, for the purchase of Bituminous Material.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The City's Purchase Order #2022034 for the purchase of Bituminous Material from Plete Construction, Inc., 1100 Brandt Dr., Hoffman Estates, Illinois, 60192, for a total amount not to exceed \$424,450, for the Public Works Department is hereby authorized (the "Purchase") and City staff is directed to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction. A copy of the City's Purchase Order #2022034 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2021-10 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.
