

RESOLUTION R-2021-36

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 194 WITH
INFINITY TECHNOLOGIES FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SECURITY CAMERAS
AT THE WATER DIVISION AND PRESIDENT STREET PUMPING STATION FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$20,747**

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 21-52) that included the purchase and installation of security cameras at the Water Division and President Street Pumping Station, and Infinity Technologies was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder with a bid amount of \$20,747; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in the Water Fund for an amount of \$23,000 for the purchase and installation of security cameras at the Water Division and President Street Pumping Station; and


WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the Bid and the agreement contained in the City's Bid package for the purchase and installation of security cameras at the Water Division and President Street Pumping Station; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with Infinity Technologies, 5521 W. 110th Street Unit 1, Oak Lawn, Illinois 60453, for the purchase and installation of security cameras at the Water Division and President Street Pumping Station.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 194 with Infinity Technologies, 5521 W. 110th Street- Unit 1, Oak Lawn, Illinois, 60453, for the purchase and installation of security cameras at the Water Division and President Street Pumping Station for a total amount not to exceed \$20,747; and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 194 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2021-36 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
