**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF
THE CITY OF WHEATON SANITARY SEWER REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton City Council has Strategic Priority 2: Enhanced Infrastructure, Goal 2: Improve programs to Reduce Sanitary Sewer Back-ups and Overflows; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has determined that the best practices to reach this goal include revisions and/or additions to existing sanitary sewer reimbursement programs; and


WHEREAS, Strategic Priority 2, Goal 2 has Initiative 2: Create Programs to provide relief for property owners experiencing basement backups and Initiative 3: Improve and implement programs for long-term private property I&I reduction; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has made revisions to improve and generated documents to implement the Residential Sewer Backup Prevention Program, Sanitary Sewer Service Line Reimbursement Program, and Foundation Footing Tile Disconnection Reimbursement Program to provide relief to property owners experiencing basement backups and implement programs for long-term private property I&I reduction; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Residential Sewer Backup Prevention Program, Sanitary Sewer Service Line Reimbursement Program, and Foundation Footing Tile Disconnection Reimbursement Program are attached as Exhibit 1, Exhibit 2, and Exhibit 3.


