

RESOLUTION R-2022-45

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 304 WITH  
A LAMP CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR PUBLIC ALLEY RECONSTRUCTION FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT  
NOT TO EXCEED \$214,914.25**

**WHEREAS**, the City prepared a bid package (Bid Number 22-85) that included Public Alley Reconstruction; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on May 20, 2022, at 11:00 AM. A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder with a bid amount of \$214,914.25; and

**WHEREAS**, the City budgeted funds in the CY2022 TIF District #3 fund in an amount of \$95,000 Public Alley Reconstruction and the TIF District #3 fund has the reserves available to accommodate the additional cost; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid proposal and the agreement contained in the City's bid package for Public Alley Reconstruction; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc., located at 1900 Wright Boulevard, Schaumburg, Illinois 60193 for Public Alley Reconstruction.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 304 with A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc., located at 1900 Wright Boulevard, Schaumburg, Illinois 60193 for Public Alley Reconstruction; and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 304 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2022-45 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
