

ORDINANCE NO. O-2024-01

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WHEATON
CHAPTER 70 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES) AND MOTOR VEHICLE SCHEDULES VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, AND XI**

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton ("City") is an Illinois Home Rule Municipality pursuant to provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, and as such the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this ordinance pertains to the government and affairs of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council and City Staff have carefully evaluated the City Code and believe certain amendments are appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois by its home rule authority, that the Wheaton City Code, Chapter 70 "Traffic and Vehicles" and Motor Vehicle Schedules VI, VII, VIII, IX, X and XI are hereby amended to provide as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following sections of Chapter 70 (Traffic and Vehicles) are hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 70-1. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning. Whenever any words, terms and phrases used in this chapter are not defined in this section but are defined in the state laws regulating the operation of vehicles, any such definition therein shall be deemed to apply to such words, terms and phrases used in this chapter.

Central Business District means all streets and portions of streets described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule I.

City means City of Wheaton.

Director means director of engineering.

Freight curb loading zone means a space adjacent to a curb for the exclusive use of vehicles during the loading or unloading of freight.

Official time standard. Whenever certain hours are named in this chapter, they shall mean standard time or daylight-saving time, as may be in current use in the city.

Park or parking means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, upon a street or in a city-owned off-street parking lot, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers, or loading or unloading merchandise, or in obedience to traffic regulations, signs or signals, or an involuntary stopping of the vehicle by reason of causes beyond the control of the operator of the vehicle.

Passenger curb loading zone means a place adjacent to a curb reserved for the exclusive use of vehicles during the loading or unloading of passengers.

Railroad train means a locomotive, diesel, electric or otherwise powered, with or without cars coupled thereto, operated upon rails.

Traffic division means the traffic division of the police department of the city, or if a traffic division is not established, then such term shall be deemed to refer to the police department of the city.

Sec. 70-4. Police officers to enforce traffic laws.

It shall be the duty of officers of the police department, or such officers as are assigned by the chief of police, to enforce all city and state traffic laws applicable to street traffic in the city and all other applicable sections of this chapter as it pertains to enforcement of this chapter.

Sec. 70-62. Duties generally.

(a) It shall be the general duty of the director to:

- (1) Determine the installation and proper timing and maintenance of traffic control devices;
- (2) Conduct engineering analyses of traffic accidents and to devise remedial measures;
- (3) Conduct engineering investigations of traffic conditions;
- (4) Plan the operation of traffic on the streets and highways of this city;
- (5) Cooperate with city officials in the development of ways and means to improve traffic conditions; and
- (6) Carry out the additional powers and duties imposed by the ordinances of the city.

(b) The director may test traffic control devices under actual conditions of traffic.

Sec. 70-63. Specific duties.

The director shall exercise the specific powers and duties with respect to traffic as provided in this division and as set forth elsewhere in this chapter.

Sec. 70-64. Placement, maintenance of traffic control devices.

The director shall place and maintain traffic control signs, signals, and devices when and as required under the traffic ordinances of the city to make effective the provisions of such ordinances, and may place and maintain such additional traffic control devices as may be deemed necessary to regulate traffic under the traffic ordinances of the city or under state law, or to guide or warn traffic.

Sec. 70-65. Designation of crosswalks; establishment of safety zones.

The director is hereby authorized to:

- (1) Designate and maintain, by appropriate devices, marks or lines upon the surface of the streets and highways, crosswalks at intersections where, in the director's opinion, there is particular danger to pedestrians crossing the streets and highways, and at such other places as may be deemed necessary.
- (2) Establish safety zones of such kind and character and at such places as may be deemed necessary for the protection of pedestrians.

Sec. 70-66. Marking of traffic lanes.

The director is hereby authorized to mark traffic lanes upon any street or highway where a regular alignment of traffic is necessary.

Sec. 70-67. Placement of turning markers, signs.

The director is authorized to place markers, buttons, or signs within or adjacent to intersections indicating the course to be traveled by vehicles turning at such intersections, and such course to be traveled as so indicated may conform to or be other than as prescribed by law or ordinance of the city.

Sec. 70-68. Restricted turns.

Whenever directed by any ordinance, the director is hereby authorized to determine those intersections at which drivers of vehicles shall not make a right, left, or U-turn and shall place proper signs at such intersections. The making of such turns may be prohibited between certain hours of any day and permitted at other hours, in which event the same shall be plainly indicated on the signs or they may be removed when such turns are permitted.

Sec. 70-69. Designation of reversible lanes during certain periods.

The director may erect signs temporarily designating lanes to be used by traffic moving in a particular direction, regardless of the centerline of the streets and highways.

Sec. 70-70. Erection of yield right-of-way signs.

Whenever any ordinance of the city directs that traffic on a street or portion thereof shall yield the right-of-way to traffic on an intersecting street, it shall be the duty of the director to place and maintain a yield right-of-way sign on each such street at the intersection at which traffic on such street is required to yield the right-of-way.

Sec. 70-71. Designation of stopping, standing, parking near hazardous, congested places.

Whenever directed by any ordinance, the director is hereby authorized to determine and designate, by proper signs, places not exceeding 150 feet in length where the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles would create an especially hazardous condition or would cause unusual delays to traffic.

Sec. 70-72. Parking on streets adjacent to schools.

Whenever directed by any ordinance, the director is hereby authorized to erect signs indicating no parking upon either or both sides of any street adjacent to any school property when such parking would, in the director's opinion, interfere with traffic or create a hazardous situation.

Sec. 70-73. Parking on narrow streets.

Whenever directed by any ordinance, the director is hereby authorized to erect signs indicating no parking upon any street when the width of the streets and highways does not exceed 21 feet, or upon one side of a street as indicated by such signs when the width of the streets and highways does not exceed 33 feet.

Sec. 70-74. Designation of angle parking.

The director shall determine upon what streets angle parking shall be permitted and shall mark or sign such streets.

Sec. 70-75. Designation of head-in parking.

The director shall determine upon what public parking lots or areas head-in parking shall be required, and shall mark or sign such parking lots and areas.

Sec. 70-76. Parking signs required.

Whenever by any ordinance of the city any parking time limit is imposed or parking is prohibited on designated streets, it shall be the duty of the director to erect appropriate signs giving notice thereof, and no such regulations shall be effective unless such signs are erected and in place at the time of any alleged offense. This section shall not apply to the prohibition of all-night parking or parking following a snowfall.

Sec. 70-79. Designation, marking of public carrier stands.

The director is hereby authorized and required to establish bus stops, bus stands, taxicab stands and stands for other passenger common carrier motor vehicles on such public streets, in such places, and in such numbers as the director shall determine to be of the greatest benefit and convenience to the public, and every such bus stop, taxicab stand, or other stand shall be designated by appropriate signs.

Sec. 70-80. Designation of parking spaces.

- (a) The director is hereby directed and authorized to mark off individual parking spaces in the metered parking zones designated and described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule IX, and in such other zones as may be established, such parking spaces to be designated by lines painted or durably marked on the curbing or surface of the street or off-street parking lot.
- (b) The director is hereby directed and authorized to designate individual parking spaces in the facilities leased for parking described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule X-D and in such other facilities as may be established, by lines painted or durably marked on the surface of such facility, and shall further cause such spaces to be individually numbered or otherwise appropriately identified.

Sec. 70-81. Parking meters.

In the metered parking zones where parking meters are to be installed, the director shall cause parking meters to be installed upon the off-street parking lot surface, curb or sidewalk immediately adjacent to the parking spaces provided for in section 70-80(a), such installation to be placed not more than two feet from the curb nor more than four feet from the front line of the parking space as indicated. Each device shall be so set as to display a signal showing legal parking upon the deposit of the appropriate coin or coins, lawful money of the United States of America, for the period of time prescribed by this chapter. Each device shall be so arranged that upon the expiration of the lawful time limit it will indicate by a proper visible signal that the lawful parking period has expired and in such cases the right of such vehicle to occupy such space shall cease and the operator, owner, possessor, or manager thereof shall be subject to the penalties provided in this chapter.

Sec. 70-82. Erection of stop signs at through streets.

Whenever any ordinance of the city designates and describes a through street, it shall be the duty of the director to place and maintain a stop sign on each and every street intersecting such through street or intersecting that portion thereof described and designated as such by any ordinance of the city unless traffic at any such intersection is controlled at all times by traffic control signals; provided, however, that at the intersection of two or more such through streets, stop signs shall be erected at the approaches of all such streets.

Sec. 70-83. Signs placed to designate one-way streets.

Whenever any ordinance of the city designates any one-way street or alley, the director shall place and maintain signs giving notice thereof, and no such regulation shall be effective unless such signs are in place. Signs indicating the direction of lawful traffic movement shall be placed at every intersection where movement of traffic in the opposite direction is prohibited.

DIVISION 3. PARKING VIOLATIONS

Sec. 70-148. Overtime parking notices; how and when payable; fines.

- (a) *Definitions.* The following words and phrases when used in this section shall have the meanings ascribed to them as set forth below:

Central business district or *CBD* means the area within the City of Wheaton bounded by Wesley Street on the north, West Street on the west, Willow Avenue on the south, and Cross Street on the east.

Commuter parking lot(s) means City Parking Lot Number 3 which is the 100 block of East Liberty Drive, City Parking Lot Number 4 which is the 100 block of West Liberty Drive, City Parking Lot Number 5 which is the 200 and 300 block of West Liberty Drive, City Parking Lot Number 6 located along Crescent Street near the College Avenue train station, City Parking Lot Number 7 located on the southeast corner of Williston and Crescent Street, City Parking Lot Number 8 located on the southwest corner of Blanchard and Crescent Street, and City Parking Lot Number 9 located at Carlton Avenue and Liberty Drive.

Compact Car(s) means vehicles named in the EPA Size Classes of compact car, subcompact car, minicompact car, and two seaters by the Oak Ridge National Laboratory for the United States Department of Energy and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

Compact Car Space(s) means any space which is duly designated for the parking of a single vehicle by lines painted or otherwise durably marked on the curb, on the surface of the street, or on the surface of the off-street parking lot where signs depicting the space as "Compact Cars Only" have been installed.

Daily fee parking zone(s) means any zone as depicted in Traffic Schedule IX as a metered parking zone and Traffic Schedule X-A as daily fee parking and where applicable signage is erected. Daily fee parking shall be a single fee for parking between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, excepting legal holidays. The fee for daily fee parking shall be as set forth in City Code Appendix B. If not between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., then daily fee parking spaces shall be free public parking. No on-street parking is allowed between the hours of 2 a.m. And 6 a.m.

Metered parking zone means any zone as depicted in Traffic Schedule IX and includes any city-owned off-street parking lot or any restricted street or portion thereof upon which daily fee signage is erected or parking meters are installed and in operation.

Premium daily fee parking zone(s) means any daily fee parking zone as depicted in Traffic Schedule IX as a metered parking zone and Traffic Schedules X-A as premium daily fee parking and where applicable signage is erected. Premium daily fee parking shall be a single fee for parking between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, excepting legal holidays. The fee for premium daily fee parking shall be as set forth in City Code - Appendix B. If not between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., then premium daily fee parking spaces shall be free public parking.

- (b) *Administrative adjudication.* The city's system of administrative adjudication as set forth in chapter 2, article X of the city code, shall not apply to the city code parking violations listed in the schedule of parking fines in subsection (c) of this section when such code violations occur in the central business district, the city's commuter parking lots, the city's daily fee parking zones, the city's premium daily fee parking zones, and the city's metered parking zones. Violations of the city code provisions listed in subsection (d) of this section which occur outside the central business district and not within the city's commuter parking lots, daily fee parking zones, premium daily fee parking zones, or metered parking zones shall be subject to the city's system of administrative adjudication set forth in chapter 2, article X of the City Code.
- (c) *Schedule of parking fines for central business district, commuter parking lots, daily fee parking zones, premium daily fee parking zones, and metered parking zones.* The following fines are imposed for the

violations listed below which occur in the central business district, commuter parking lots, daily fee parking zones, premium daily fee parking zones, and metered parking zones:

- (e) If the owner or operator of a vehicle receiving a violation notice for a violation listed under subsection (c) or (d) of this section continues to park his vehicle in the same location for a period of time which again exceeds the designated time limit, such owner shall be subject to an additional fine. Each continued time limit violation shall constitute a separate offense.
- (f) Administrative ticket processing fees shall be paid in accordance with Appendix B (Fee Schedule) to this Code.

DIVISION 4. ENFORCEMENT ON PRIVATE STREETS IN PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENTS

Sec. 70-172. Agreement required.

Following receipt of a written request pursuant to section 70-171, the city, in its sole discretion, may elect to enter into an agreement with the homeowners' association or owner of a planned unit development to authorize the enforcement of certain traffic regulations within the planned unit development. The agreement shall be of a form and include any provisions deemed appropriate by the city council, and may generally address the enforcement of parking or of traffic regulations pertaining to the pedestrian safety, designated fire lane zones, overnight parking, and improper storage of vehicles. The city council may require that a study, at the sole cost of

the homeowners' association or owner of a planned unit development, be conducted in order to determine the appropriate traffic regulations to be enforced within the planned unit development. The agreement shall contain any such provisions as the city determines necessary.

Sec. 70-173. Violation of regulations imposed by traffic enforcement agreements.

It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any regulations imposed pursuant to the provisions of a traffic enforcement agreement entered into pursuant to the city's home rule powers and 625 ILCS 5/11-209.1. Such violations shall be subject to the penalties provided in this chapter.

Sec. 70-203. Load restrictions.

Whenever directed by any ordinance, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall operate any vehicle with a gross weight in excess of the amounts specified in motor vehicle and traffic schedule XIII at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in such schedule.

Sec. 70-205. Driving in processions.

Each driver in a funeral or other procession shall drive as near to the right-hand edge of the street or highway as practical and shall follow the vehicle ahead as close as is practical and safe.

Sec. 70-206. Use of roller skates, coasters, toy vehicles.

No person upon roller skates, in-line skates, or riding in or by means of any coaster, toy vehicle, or similar device, shall go upon any street or highway except while crossing a street on a crosswalk, and when so crossing, such person shall be granted all of the rights and shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to pedestrians.

Sec. 70-209. Same—Declared nuisance; notice to remove.

Any obstruction in violation of section 70-208 is hereby declared to be a nuisance and it shall be the duty of the director to cause a notice to be served upon the owners or occupants of all property where such violations exist to remove such obstructions within seven days from the service of such notice.

Sec. 70-210. Same—Failure to remove.

The owner or occupant of any property who shall fail to remove any such obstruction prohibited in section 70-208 within seven days after the service of notice as provided for in section 70-209 shall be deemed to be in violation of this chapter. A separate offense shall be deemed to have been committed on every day that such obstruction is permitted to remain after the expiration of the period of seven days after the service of such notice.

Sec. 70-211. Certain turns prohibited at certain intersections.

Certain turns, as indicated, at the intersections as described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule XIV are hereby prohibited.

Sec. 70-212. Trucks prohibited from certain streets.

Truck traffic on the streets described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule XV is prohibited.

Sec. 70-238. Removal of prohibited signs; request for directional signs by certain institutions.

- (a) Every sign, signal or marking prohibited by 625 ILCS 5/11-310 is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and the authority having jurisdiction over the highway is hereby empowered to remove such prohibited sign, signal or marking or cause it to be removed without notice.
- (b) Churches, religious facilities of worship, and private schools quartering the majority of their students in dormitories where such number of resident students exceed 50 are permitted upon their request to cause the installation of no more than two directional signs within the city limits which will be allowed on public right-of-way locations approved by the director ; such directional signs shall be substantially equal in size to the then current street name signs used in the city, shall consist of white lettering on blue background, shall be affixed to either the existing street name pole or street lighting pole, and shall be installed by city employees. The cost of installing such signs shall be \$50.00 each, to be paid by the requesting party.

Sec. 70-261. State law applicable; exceptions.

The state traffic laws regulating the speed of vehicles shall be applicable upon all streets within the city. However, the city, as authorized by state law, hereby declares and determines upon the basis of engineering and traffic investigations that certain speed regulations shall be applicable upon specified streets or in certain areas, as set out in schedules I, II, and XI, in which event it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of any speed so declared under such schedules when signs are in place giving notice thereof.

Sec. 70-286. Obedience to signs.

Upon those streets and parts of streets and in those alleys described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule III-A, vehicular traffic shall move only in the direction indicated when signs indicating the direction of traffic are erected and maintained at every intersection where movement in the opposite direction is prohibited.

Sec. 70-287. Streets designated one-way during certain periods.

Upon those streets and parts of streets and in those alleys described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule III-B, vehicular traffic shall move only in the direction indicated during the time period indicated in such schedule when signs indicating the direction of traffic and the time periods related thereto are erected and maintained at every intersection where movement in the opposite direction is prohibited.

Sec. 70-306. Through streets designated.

Those streets and parts of streets described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule IV are hereby declared to be through streets.

Sec. 70-307. Yield right-of-way intersections designated.

Those street intersections described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule XII, traffic control signals, are hereby declared to be designated for traffic control signal intersections.

Sec. 70-338. Prohibited in specified places.

(a) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:

- (1) On a sidewalk.
- (2) In front of a public or private driveway.
- (3) Within an intersection.
- (4) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- (5) On a crosswalk.
- (6) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection.
- (7) Within 30 feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, yield right-of-way sign, or traffic control signal located at the side of a street or highway.
- (8) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless the city traffic engineer has indicated a different length by signs or markings.
- (9) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing.
- (10) Within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within 75 feet of said entrance when the proper sign is posted.
- (11) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic.
- (12) On a street or highway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street.

- (13) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway or within a highway tunnel.
 - (14) At any place where official signs prohibit stopping, standing or parking.
 - (15) Between the curb or edge of the pavement and the public sidewalk or property line.
- (b) No person other than a police officer shall move a vehicle not lawfully under his control into any of the areas hereinabove prohibited or away from a curb such distance as is unlawful, or start or cause to be started the motor of any motor vehicle, or shift, change or move the levers, brake, starting device, gears or other mechanism of a parked motor vehicle to a position other than that in which it was left by the owner or driver thereof, or attempt to do so.

Sec. 70-339. Standing, parking close to curb.

No person shall stand or park a vehicle in a street or highway other than parallel with the edge of a street or highway headed in the direction of lawful traffic movement and with the wheels of the vehicle within 18 inches of the curb or edge of the street or highway except as otherwise provided in this article.

Sec. 70-341. Parking not to obstruct traffic.

No person shall park any vehicle upon a street or alley in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the street or highway for the free movement of vehicular traffic.

Sec. 70-342. Parking in alleys prohibited; exception.

No person shall park a vehicle within an alley except for the purpose of loading or unloading merchandise, provided such loading and unloading is in accordance with all other applicable ordinances and then in such manner and in such conditions as to leave available not less than ten feet of the width of the street or highway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within an alley in such a position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property.

Sec. 70-346. Parking for certain purposes prohibited.

No person shall park a vehicle upon any street or highway for the principal purpose of:

- (1) Displaying such vehicle for sale;
- (2) Washing, greasing, or repairing such vehicle, except for repairs necessitated by an emergency.

Sec. 70-347. Obedience to parking signs and markings; parking to be within designated space.

Upon those streets and off-street lots which have been signed or marked by the city for parking, no person shall park or stand a vehicle other than at the angle to the curb or edge of the street or highway indicated by such signs or markings. At each parking space so marked off, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle in such a way that such vehicle shall not be entirely within the limits of the spaces so designated.

Sec. 70-354. Restrictions or prohibitions on certain streets and off-street lots.

- (a) *Application of section.* The provisions of this section prohibiting the standing or parking of a vehicle shall apply at all times or at those times specified in this section or as indicated on official signs, except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.
- (b) *Regulations not exclusive.* The provisions of this section imposing a time limit on parking shall not relieve any person from the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions prohibiting or limiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles in specified places or at specified times.
- (c) *Parking prohibited at all times.* When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or portions thereof described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule VI, "Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets".
- (d) *Parking prohibited during certain hours.* When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours and days specified upon any of the streets or portions thereof described in motor vehicle and traffic schedule VII, "Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets".
- (e) *On-street parking time limited.* When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time designated in motor vehicle and traffic schedule VIII on any day except Sundays and legal holidays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. upon any of the streets described in such schedule. For the purpose of this subsection, a separate offense occurs at the expiration of each maximum parking time limit, and no person shall move a vehicle from space to space within the designated parking zone in order to extend the parking time limit for their use.
- (f) *Off-street parking time limited.* When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time designated in motor vehicle and traffic schedule VIII on any day except Sundays and legal holidays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. in any off-street parking lot designated in such schedule. For the purpose of this subsection, a separate offense occurs at the expiration of each maximum parking time limit, and no person shall move a vehicle from space to space within the designated parking zone in order to extend the parking time limit for their use.
- (g) *On-street parking time limited.* When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time designated in motor vehicle and traffic schedule VIII on any day except Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on any of the streets described in such schedule. For the purpose of this subsection, a separate offense occurs at the expiration of each maximum parking time limit, and no person shall move a vehicle from space to space within the designated parking zone in order to extend the parking time limit for their use.
- (h) *Legal holiday exception.* For purposes of this chapter, legal holidays shall be: City of Wheaton observed legal holidays as established in section 2-36(b), State of Illinois observed legal holidays as established in 205 ILCS 630/17(a) or United States Federal observed legal holidays as established in 5 U.S. Code § 6103. Holidays (a).

- (i) *Downtown on-street parking time limited.* When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time designated in motor vehicle and traffic schedule VIII on any day except legal holidays upon any of the streets described in such schedule. For the purpose of this subsection, a separate offense occurs at the expiration of each maximum parking time limit, and no person shall move a vehicle from space to space within the designated parking zone in order to extend the parking time limit for their use.

Sec. 70-356. Customer designated parking.

- (a) No person who owns, operates, manages, or is employed at a place of business in the zone bounded by Seminary, Scott, Illinois, and West Streets shall park in spaces designated as customer parking only, while the person is working at the business.
- (b) Customer designated parking shall include the following street blocks: 100 block of North Main Street, East Front Street, East Wesley Street, and East Liberty Drive; 100, 200 and 300 blocks of West Front Street (except the south side in front of 312 West Front Street) and West Wesley Street (except the south side of the 200 block between the alley and Wheaton Avenue and the north side of the 300 block); 100 and 200 blocks of West Liberty Drive (except the north side of the 200 block) and North Hale Street (except north of Karlskoga Avenue); Parking Lot #2 located south of West Wesley Street between Main Street and Hale Street; Level 1 and Level 2 of the Wheaton Place Garage; and the ground level of the Willow Avenue Garage.
- (c) It shall be a rebuttable presumption that any person who is an employee of a business in the central business district shall be deemed to be working at his place of business Monday through Sunday.
- (d) Only those persons seeking to purchase merchandise or services within the central business district shall be allowed to park a vehicle in customer designated parking locations. All other vehicles, including those parking for train commuting purposes, are prohibited.
- (e) Renting an apartment in the central business district shall not be considered to be seeking to purchase merchandise or services within the central business district as per subsection (d) and does not grant renters the right to use customer designated parking for the daily storage of their vehicle. Renters must use leased parking if a parking space is not provided on private property.

DIVISION 2. METERED PARKING

Sec. 70-376. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this division, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Daily fee parking space means any space within a metered parking zone, which is duly designated for the parking of a single vehicle by lines painted or otherwise durably marked on the curb, on the surface of the street,

or on the surface of the off-street parking lot as depicted by applicable daily fee signage and in the general vicinity of a pay-by-plate pay station or online payment process. Daily fee parking shall be a single fee for parking between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. If not between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., then daily fee parking spaces shall be free public parking. No on-street parking is allowed between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m.

Daily fee parking zone(s) means any zone as depicted in Traffic Schedule IX as a metered parking zone and Traffic Schedule X-A as daily fee parking and where applicable signage is erected. Daily fee parking shall be a single fee for parking between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, excepting legal holidays. The fee for daily fee parking shall be as set forth in City Code Appendix B. If not between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., then daily fee parking spaces shall be free public parking. No on-street parking is allowed between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m.

Metered parking zone means and includes any city-owned off-street parking lot or any restricted street or portion thereof upon which daily fee signage is erected or parking meters are installed and in operation.

Parking meter means and includes a mechanical device or meter not inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter placed or erected for the regulation of parking by authority of this division. Each parking meter installed shall indicate by proper legend the legal parking time established by the city and when operated shall at all times indicate the balance of legal parking time, and at the expiration of such period shall indicate illegal or overtime parking.

Parking meter space means any space within a metered parking zone, adjacent to a parking meter, which is duly designated for the parking of a single vehicle by lines painted or otherwise durably marked on the curb, on the surface of the street, or on the surface of the off-street parking lot adjacent to or adjoining the parking meters.

Premium daily fee parking zone(s) means any daily fee parking zone as depicted in Traffic Schedule IX as a metered parking zone and Traffic Schedule X-A as premium daily fee parking and where applicable signage is erected. Premium daily fee parking shall be a single fee for parking between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, excepting legal holidays. The fee for premium daily fee parking shall be as set forth in City Code - Appendix B. If not between the hours of 6 a.m. to 3 p.m., then premium daily fee parking spaces shall be free public parking.

Sec. 70-378. Zones established.

The named and described areas, streets, or portions of streets contained in motor vehicle and traffic schedule IX, and such other areas, streets, or portions of streets as may be included in such schedule by amendment thereto, lying within the corporate limits of the city, shall constitute a metered parking zone which is inclusive of parking meters, daily fee parking, and premium daily fee parking.

Sec. 70-379. Parking to be within designated space.

At each metered parking space so marked off in a metered parking zone, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle in such a way that such vehicle shall not be entirely within the limits of the spaces so designated.

Sec. 70-381. Operation of; duty to deposit coin; unused time.

- (a) Except in a period of emergency determined by an officer of the fire or police department, or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control sign or signal, when any vehicle shall be parked in any parking space alongside or next to which a parking meter is located, the operator of such vehicle shall, upon entering such parking meter space, immediately deposit or cause to be deposited in such meter such proper coin(s) of the United States as is required for such parking meter and as is designated by proper directions on the meter, and when required by the directions of the meter, the operator of such vehicle, after the deposit of the proper or coin(s), shall also set in operation the timing mechanism on such meter in accordance with directions appearing thereon. Failure to deposit such proper coin(s), and to set the timing mechanism in operation when so required, shall constitute a violation of this division.
- (b) Upon the deposit of the required coin(s), and the setting of the timing mechanism in operation when so required, the meter parking space may be lawfully occupied by such vehicle during the period of time which has been prescribed for the part of the street or off-street parking lot in which such parking space is located; provided, that any person placing a vehicle in a parking meter space adjacent to a meter which indicates that unused time has been left in the meter by the previous occupant of the space shall not be required to deposit a coin(s) so long as his occupancy of such space does not exceed the indicated unused parking time. If such vehicle shall remain parked in any such parking space beyond the parking time limit set for such parking space, and if the meter shall indicate such illegal parking, then, and in that event, such vehicle shall be considered as parking overtime and beyond the period of legal parking time, and such parking shall be deemed a violation of this division.

Sec. 70-382. Parking time limits.

- (a) No person shall park a vehicle in a parking meter space for a period of time in excess of the maximum parking time limit for such space as set forth in motor vehicle and traffic schedules X-A and X-C. For the purposes of this subsection, a separate offense occurs at the expiration of each maximum parking time limit, and no person shall move a vehicle from space to space within the designated parking zone in order to extend the parking time limit for their use.
- (b) Parking or standing a vehicle in a parking meter space shall be lawful upon the deposit in the parking meter adjacent thereto of the required coins as set forth in Appendix B to this Code.
- (c) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, parking meters shall be operated in metered parking zones between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, except legal holidays as set forth in motor vehicle and traffic schedule X-A.
- (d) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, parking meters shall be operated in metered parking zones between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Sunday, except legal holidays as set forth in motor vehicle and traffic schedule X-A.
- (e) Parking or standing a vehicle in a daily fee parking space shall be lawful for the same day as the deposit was made and shall be lawful only upon the deposit of the daily parking fee using the pay-by-plate pay station or online payment process. The fee shall be as set forth in Appendix B to this Code.
- (f) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, daily fee parking shall be operated in daily fee parking zones between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays as set forth in motor vehicle and traffic schedule X-A.

- (g) Parking or standing a vehicle in a premium daily fee parking space shall be lawful for the same day as the deposit was made and shall be lawful only upon the deposit of the premium daily parking fee using the pay-by-plate pay station or online payment process. The fee shall be as set forth in Appendix B to this Code.
- (h) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, premium daily fee parking shall be operated in premium daily fee parking zones between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays as set forth in motor vehicle and traffic schedule X-A.

Sec. 70-383. Violations.

It shall be unlawful and a violation of the provisions of this division for any person to:

- (1) Cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of, or operated by, such person to be parked overtime at any parking meter.
- (2) Permit any vehicle to remain or be placed in any parking space adjacent to any parking meter while such meter is displaying a signal indicating that the vehicle occupying such parking space has already been parked beyond the period prescribed for such parking space.
- (3) Park any vehicle across any line or marking of a parking meter space or in such position that the vehicle shall not be entirely within the area designated by such lines or markings.
- (4) Deface, injure, tamper with, open or willfully break, destroy or impair the usefulness of any parking meter installed under the provisions of this division.
- (5) Deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any slug, device or metal substance, or other substitute for lawful coins.
- (6) Deposit or cause to be deposited in the envelope being a part of the notice of violation under this division any substance or material other than the lawful currency or coins necessary to satisfy such violation in full.
- (7) Deposit in any parking meter any coin for the purpose of parking beyond the maximum legal parking time for the particular metered parking zone, or parking beyond the period of legal parking time established for any metered parking zone as described in this division (i.e., meter feeding).

Sec. 70-384. Overtime parking notice.

Any vehicle which remains parked in a parking meter space after the meter indicates illegal parking shall be considered as parking overtime, and the police officers or parking enforcement of the city are authorized and directed to attach to any such vehicle a notice to the owner or operator thereof that such vehicle has been parked in violation of this division.

Sec. 70-385. Collection of meter monies.

It shall be the duty of the chief of police to designate an employee or employees of the police department to make regular collections of the money deposited in parking meters, and it shall be the duty of such persons so designated to remove from such meters the coins so deposited in the meters and to deliver such coins to the finance department.

Sec. 70-386. Disposition of monies collected.

All revenues derived from parking meters shall be deposited in a separate fund designated as the Parking Fund of the city, which shall be used only in paying the cost of operation and maintenance of the parking facilities of the city and in paying the principal and interest on the bonds of the city which by their terms are payable only from the revenues of the motor vehicle parking facilities of the city.

Sec. 70-387. Unauthorized use of parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities.

- (a) Any motor vehicle bearing registration plates issued to a person with disabilities or to a disabled veteran, or any motor vehicle bearing an official person with disabilities decal, sticker, sign or insignia, properly displayed, thereby designating the motor vehicle as being operated by, or for, a person with disabilities, shall be exempt from payment of parking meter fees and shall be exempt from any ordinance imposing time limitations on parking within a certain zone, except meters, or time limitation of one-half hour or less in any lot or parking place which is owned or leased by the city.
- (b) Any person with disabilities-designated motor vehicle is subject to the ordinances which prohibit the following: Parking in no parking zone, parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, parking in a fire lane, overnight parking, parking in loading zones, parking which obstructs driveways, parking in bus stops and in parking spaces leased by the city.
- (c) It shall be prohibited to park any motor vehicle which is not bearing the person with disabilities designation recited in subsection (a) of this section in any parking place or parking space, including any private or public off-street parking facility, which is specifically reserved for motor vehicles bearing a person with disabilities designation by the posting of an official sign, as defined herein.
- (d) The city, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-1301.2 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, as amended, may issue a special person with disabilities motorist parking permit to a person with disabilities who is a resident of the city. The person with disabilities motorist parking permit shall be the property of the person with disabilities and may be used by the person with disabilities to designate and identify a motor vehicle not owned by the person with disabilities and/or not bearing the state person with disabilities registration plates only when the motor vehicle is being used to transport the person, thereby providing the motor vehicle and its driver/owner with all privileges that would be afforded to a person with disabilities-licensed vehicle. Any city resident with temporary disabilities requesting a person with disabilities motorist parking permit must submit a written application to the city police department. Applications for the permit shall be made upon a form provided by the police department and must be accompanied by a letter or affidavit from a physician reciting and certifying the specific disability. Temporary person with disabilities motorist parking permits are valid for no more than 90 days; the initial fee for the permit shall be two dollars with no fee for any renewal thereafter. Person with disabilities motorist parking permits must be displayed in the interior of the front of the motor vehicle transporting such person with disabilities.
- (e) Signs illustrating notice of the reservation of parking places for persons with disabilities shall conform to the provisions recited in chapter 625 ILCS 5/11-301 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, as amended.

Sec. 70-411. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this division, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Facility for leased parking means any city-owned, leased, managed or controlled off-street parking lot or facility, or any portion thereof, in which the city leases parking spaces.

Leased parking space means any space within a facility for leased parking, and which is duly designated for the parking of single vehicles by lines painted on the surface of such facility.

Parking authorization means a decal, sticker, card, permit, or any other official designation issued by the city, and sold for such amounts as the city council may from time to time determine by ordinance, by the finance department.

Sec. 70-413. Established.

The named and described facilities contained in motor vehicle and traffic schedule X-D, "Leased Parking", and such other areas as may be included in such schedule by amendment thereto, lying within the corporate limits of the city, shall constitute facilities for leased parking. The priorities, if any, with respect to the leasing of parking facilities shall be determined and implemented by the city manager.

Sec. 70-414. Illegal parking.

It shall be unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of, or operated by, such person to be parked in a leased parking space without first obtaining parking authorization for such space. Any vehicle parked in a leased parking space without the appropriate parking authorization shall be considered illegally parked. The police officers of the city are authorized to remove and tow away, or to have removed and towed away by a licensed commercial towing service, any such illegally parked vehicle. Vehicles so towed away for illegal parking shall be restored to the owner or operator of such vehicle upon payment of towing and storage fees, as established by the chief of police with the approval of the licensed commercial towing firms.

Sec. 70-415. Application for parking authorization.

- (a) Application for leased parking authorization shall be made in writing upon forms furnished by the finance department. Fees for leased parking under this section shall be in accordance with appendix B to this Code.
- (b) The finance department shall refuse to consider any application for leased parking authorization from any person who has outstanding debt owed to the city. In such instances, the finance department or other authorized designee shall return the application to the applicant with a letter informing the applicant of the basis for the refusal of the application.
- (c) The finance department or other authorized designee shall not issue, cause to be issued or renew a leased parking authorization to any person who has any outstanding debt owed to the city. In such instances, the finance department or other authorized designee shall return the renewal application to the applicant with a letter informing the applicant of the basis for the refusal of the renewal application.
- (d) When reviewing an application for parking authorization, the finance department or other authorized designee has the authority and is directed to examine city parking ticket records to determine whether the applicant has any outstanding debt owed to the city.

No pedestrian shall cross a street or highway other than in a crosswalk.

ARTICLE VI. BICYCLES

Sec. 70-516. Bicycle equipment required when same is being operated within the city.

Bicycles operated in the city are required to have the following equipment:

- (1) An operational bell or horn which is audible at a distance of 100 feet.
- (2) A brake in good working condition which will enable the operator to make the braked wheel skid on a dry, level, clean pavement.
- (3) A lamp which shall emit a white light, located on the front of the bicycle, which is visible on the front and from a distance of at least 500 feet. The lamp needs to be used during operation of the bicycle between the hours of sunset and sunrise.

ARTICLE VIII. ABANDONED AND INOPERABLE VEHICLES

Sec. 70-574. Citations.

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep any abandoned, hazardous, inoperable, or unlawful vehicle, as defined in section 70-566, on any real property in the city. Any person notified of a violation of this section by the police department or its duty authorized agent, is subject to being cited and towed for a violation of this section, if the violation exists on the seventh day after a notice of violation was served. Notice may be given by placing a notice of violation sticker on the vehicle. Any person who is issued a citation for a violation of this section shall remove the vehicle in compliance with this article within seven days from the date of the citation.

- (1) Any person who has received a citation for a violation of this section, but who has removed the vehicle before a tow could be made, shall pay a \$100.00 fine to the city within 15 days of the date of the citation. Failure to pay the fine within 15 days of the date of the citation shall result in a mandatory court appearance. Upon a plea or finding of guilt, the violator shall be subject to a fine not less than \$150.00 nor more than \$500.00, plus court costs.
- (2) Any person who has received a citation for a violation of this section and whose vehicle has been towed, shall pay a \$100.00 fine to the city directly, in addition to any towing and storage fees that the owner, lienholder, or other person legally entitled to the vehicle is obligated to pay, prior to the release of the vehicle, in accordance with the other provisions of this article. Such persons may contest the fine as a part of the review process set forth in the other provisions of this article. Those persons who do not pay the \$100.00 fine and who do not seek the release of the vehicle shall be subject to a mandatory court appearance. Upon a plea or finding of guilt, the violator shall be subject to a fine not less than \$150.00 nor more than \$500.00, plus court costs.



SECTION 3: In all other respects, the terms and provisions of the Wheaton City Code are ratified and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.

To maximize the number of parking spaces available to the public in the evenings during the week and on weekends, leased parking at the Willow Avenue Garage is available exclusively to leaseholders Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., after which parking is free and open to the public based on availability.
