

ORDINANCE NO. O-2025-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WHEATON
CHAPTER 70 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES), ARTICLE IV (STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING), APPENDIX B
(FEE SCHEDULE), AND MOTOR VEHICLE SCHEDULES VIII, X-C, AND X-D

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton ("City") is an Illinois Home Rule Municipality pursuant to provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, and as such the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this ordinance pertains to the government and affairs of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council and City Staff have carefully evaluated the City Code and believe certain amendments are appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois by its home rule authority, that the Wheaton City Code, Chapter 70 "Traffic and Vehicles", Motor Vehicle Schedules VIII. Parking time (non-metered) limited on certain streets and off-street lots, X-C. Metered parking zone time limits – off streets, and X-D. Leased Parking, and Appendix B are hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following sections of Chapter 70 (Traffic and Vehicles), Article IV (Stopping, Standing and Parking) are hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 70-356. - Customer designated parking.

- (a) No person who owns, operates, manages, or is employed at a place of business in the zone bounded by Seminary, Scott, Illinois, and West Streets shall park in spaces designated as customer parking only, while the person is working at the business.
- (b) Customer designated parking shall include the following street blocks: 100 block of North Main Street, East Front Street, East Wesley Street, and East Liberty Drive; 100, 200 and 300 blocks of West Front Street (except the south side in front of 312 West Front Street) and West Wesley Street (except the south side of the 200 block between the alley and Wheaton Avenue and the north side of the 300 block); 100 and 200 blocks of West Liberty Drive (including the south line of parking spaces located in Parking Lot #4 which are immediately adjoining Liberty Drive), but excepting the north side of the 200 block and North Hale Street (except north of Karlsga Avenue); 100 and 200 blocks of North Wheaton Avenue; 100 block of West Willow Avenue; 200 block of South Wheaton Avenue; 200 block of South Hale Street; 200 block of South Main Street; Parking Lot #2 located south of West Wesley Street between Main Street and Hale Street; Level 1 and Level 2 of the Wheaton Place Garage; and the ground level of the Willow Avenue Garage.
- (c) It shall be a rebuttable presumption that any person who is an employee of a business in the central business district shall be deemed to be working at his place of business Monday through Sunday.

(d) Only those persons seeking to purchase merchandise or services within the central business district shall be allowed to park a vehicle in customer designated parking locations. All other vehicles, including those parking for train commuting purposes, are prohibited.

(e) Renting an apartment in the central business district shall not be considered to be seeking to purchase merchandise or services within the central business district as per subsection (d) and does not grant renters the right to use customer designated parking for the daily storage of their vehicle. Renters must use leased parking if a parking space is not provided on private property.

SECTION 2: That a new Division 4 (Blue Dot Parking Program) is added to Article IV (Stopping, Standing and Parking) of Chapter 70 (Traffic and Vehicles), to read as follows:

DIVISION 4. – BLUE DOT PARKING PROGRAM

Sec. 70-430. Purpose.

The purpose of the city's Blue Dot Parking Program, effective July 1, 2025, is to allow employees of businesses located within the area bounded by Seminary Street on the north, Illinois Street on the south, Washington Street on the east, and West Street on the west, and adjacent areas as determined by the city, to be exempt from parking time restrictions in designated parking spaces while said employees are at work.

Sec. 70-431. Permit required.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park for longer than the time restrictions in a Blue Dot parking space without first obtaining and displaying a parking permit for such space. Any vehicle parked in a Blue Dot parking space longer than the time restriction without the appropriate parking permit shall be considered illegally parked.

Sec. 70-432. Application for permit.

- (a) Application for a Blue Dot parking permit shall be made in writing upon forms furnished by the finance department.
- (b) Fees for Blue Dot parking permits shall be in accordance with Appendix B to this Code. Beginning January 1, 2026, the permit fee shall not be prorated if purchased after the start of each year.
- (c) An eligible business, which is one that is located within the area bounded by Seminary Street on the north, Illinois Street on the south, Washington Street on the east, and West Street on the west, and adjacent areas as determined by the city, may apply for a Blue Dot parking permit.
- (d) The finance department shall not consider any initial or renewal application for a Blue Dot parking permit from any business which has any outstanding debt owed to the city. In such instances, the finance department or other authorize designee shall return the application to the applicant with a letter informing the applicant of the basis for the refusal of the application.

Sec. 70-433. Conditions of permit.

- (a) Eligible businesses may apply for more than one Blue Dot parking permit; provided however, the city may limit the number of permits granted to each business.
- (b) The permits are to be given to employees of said businesses for their use. The permits are transferable among employees of the same business.
- (c) The permits shall only be used by the employee during the employee's working hours for said business.
- (d) Employees may park in a Blue Dot parking space for longer than the posted time restriction only when displaying a Blue Dot parking permit; however, an employee is not guaranteed a specific parking space for use.
- (e) Permits shall not be sold, assigned, lent, or otherwise transferred for use to another business.

Sec. 70-434. Blue Dot parking zones.

The following streets are hereby designated as Blue Dot parking zones in which it shall be lawful for an employee of an eligible business to park beyond the permitted time restrictions while displaying a valid city Blue Dot parking permit:

- (1) Union Avenue – Both sides from Wheaton Avenue to Hale Street
- (2) Seminary Avenue – South side from Gary Avenue to West Street
- (3) Wesley Street – Both sides from Gary Avenue to West Street
- (4) West Street – West side from Seminary Avenue to Wesley Street
- (5) Hale Street – Both sides from Union Avenue to Seminary Avenue
- (6) Karlskoga Avenue – Both sides from Wheaton Avenue to Hale Street
- (7) Seminary Avenue – South side from Main Street to Cross Street
- (8) Seminary Avenue – South side from Cross Street to Scott Street
- (9) Wesley Street – Both sides from Cross Street to Scott Street
- (10) Wesley Street – Both sides from Scott Street to Washington Street
- (11) Cross Street – Both sides from Wesley Street to Front Street
- (12) Cross Street – East side from Liberty Drive to Willow Avenue
- (13) Scott Street – West side from Seminary Avenue to Wesley Street
- (14) Scott Street – Both sides from Wesley Street to Front Street
- (15) Front Street – South side from Cross Street to Scott Street
- (16) Front Street – South side from Scott Street to 215 feet east thereof
- (17) Reber Street – Both sides from Liberty Drive to Willow Avenue
- (18) Willow Avenue – Both sides from Wheaton Avenue to Hale Street
- (19) Willow Avenue – Both sides from Main Street to Cross Street
- (20) Willow Avenue – South side from Reber Street to Naperville Road
- (21) Willow Avenue – South side from Naperville Road to Washington Street
- (22) Illinois Street – South side from Main Street to Reber Street
- (23) Illinois Street – South side from Reber Street to Naperville Road
- (24) Naperville Road – East side from Liberty Drive to Willow Avenue
- (25) Naperville Road – Both sides from Willow Avenue to Illinois Street
- (26) Carlton Avenue – West side from 135 feet north of Childs Street to 375 feet south thereof

SECTION 3: That the following Motor Vehicle Schedules of Chapter 70 (Traffic and Vehicles) are hereby amended as follows:

1. Schedule VIII. Parking time (non-metered) limited on certain streets and off-street lots. (Sec. 70-354) attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1
2. Schedule X-C. Metered parking zone time limits - off street. (Sec. 70-382) attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 2
3. Schedule X-D. Leased Parking. (Sec. 70-413) attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 3

SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.

Schedule X-D. Leased Parking (Sec.70-413)

Pursuant to section 70-413, the following areas are hereby designated as facilities for leased parking. Fees for leased parking shall be in accordance with appendix B of this Code.

- (1) Parking Lot # 3 (north side of Liberty Drive between Cross Street and Main Street), leased parking Monday through Friday, 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., except legal holidays.
- (2) Parking Lot # 4 (north side of Liberty Drive between Main Street and Hale Street) excepting the south line of parking spaces located in Parking Lot #4 which are immediately adjoining Liberty Drive, leased parking Monday through Friday, except legal holidays. No parking allowed Friday from 2 a.m. to 6 a.m.
- (3) Parking Lot # 5 (north side of Liberty Drive between Hale Street and West Street), leased parking Monday through Friday, except legal holidays. No parking allowed Friday from 2 a.m. to 6 a.m.
- (4) Parking Lot #6 (north side of Crescent Street west of Hill Avenue), leased parking Monday through Friday, except legal holidays.
- (5) Parking Lot # 7 (southeast corner of Williston Street and Crescent Street), leased parking Monday through Friday, except legal holidays.
- (6) Parking Lot # 8 (northwest corner of Blanchard Street and Avery Avenue), leased parking Monday through Friday, except legal holidays.
- (7) Parking Lot # 9 (southwest corner of Liberty Drive and Carlton Avenue), leased parking Monday through Friday, except legal holidays.
- (8) Wheaton Place Garage (located at Wheaton Avenue between Wesley Street and Front Street), leased parking spaces are available on floors 3 and 4, Monday through Sunday, to persons residing in a dwelling (Residential Lease) located in the area within the City of Wheaton bounded by West Street on the west, Seminary Avenue on the north, Washington Street on the east, and Illinois Street on the south, hereinafter referred to as the "Boundary" and their guests (Condo Guest Parking), and on floors 3 and 4, Monday though Friday, to persons who own, operate, manage, or are employed at a place of business (Commercial Lease) located within the Boundary. The leased parking area on floor 4 is excepting daily fee parking spaces as delineated in Schedule X-C, Monday through Friday. To maximize the number of parking spaces available to the public in the evenings during the week and on weekends, leased parking at the Wheaton Place Garage is available exclusively to leaseholders Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., after which parking is free and open to the public based on availability.
