

RESOLUTION R-2025-33

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF VEHICLE UPFITTING EQUIPMENT FROM
FLEET SAFETY SUPPLY FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$51,857.93**

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton, Illinois, ("City") is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and as such the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited a Request for Proposal package (RFP Number 25-83) for Vehicle Upfitting Equipment and received and reviewed one (1) proposal; and

WHEREAS, staff determined the proposal submitted by Fleet Safety Supply meets the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in the Fleet Services Fund for the purchase of Vehicle Upfitting Equipment; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the Request for Proposal package for Vehicle Upfitting Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find that it is in the best interest of the City to procure Vehicle Upfitting Equipment from Fleet Safety Supply located at 127-A S. Washington St., Naperville, IL 60540 for Vehicle Upfitting Equipment for a total amount not to exceed \$51,857.93.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as findings of the Mayor and the City Council.

Section 2. The City's Purchase Order #2026060 for the purchase of Vehicle Upfitting Equipment from Fleet Safety Supply located at 127-A S. Washington St., Naperville, IL 60540 for a total amount not to exceed \$51,857.93 is hereby authorized (the "Purchase"). A copy of the City's Purchase Order #2026060 is on file with the City Clerk's office, and is incorporated herein as if fully set forth as Exhibit A.

Section 3. City staff is authorized and directed to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction.
