

ORDINANCE NO. O-2025-52

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF WHEATON  
CALENDAR YEAR 2026 BUDGET

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wheaton has heretofore adopted the Illinois Municipal Budget Law as set out in 65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.1 through 5/8-2-9.10; and

**WHEREAS**, copies of the City of Wheaton Calendar Year 2026 Draft Budget have been made available for use and examination by the public since November 3, 2025 and discussed at the public budget workshop session held on November 10, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing on the budget was also held on December 8, 2025.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the City of Wheaton Calendar Year 2026 Draft Budget, as revised, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk, and made part hereof by reference, be and is hereby passed and adopted as the Annual Budget of the City of Wheaton for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2026. A summary of said Budget is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1.

**Section 2.** That the City Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause a certified copy of this ordinance to be filed with the County Clerk of DuPage County.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
