**A RESOLUTION APPROVING
BILLY GRAHM CENTER PLAT OF CONSOLIDATION AND EASEMENT
ABROGATION
(500 COLLEGE AVENUE)**

WHEREAS, Wheaton College, the owner of property described below has presented a plat of consolidation to the City for approval;

Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 10 (except the west 137.94 feet as measured along the north and south lines thereof), and 12 in County Clerks Assessment Division of Landon's Survey, being a Subdivision of the east half of Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 10 East of the Third Principal Meridian, together with a strip of land 16 feet in width lying immediately south of and adjoining said lots 6 also:

All of McGinnis's Subdivision (lots 1 through 9 and lots A through G), being a subdivision of the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 10 East of the Third Principal Meridian, except that part of said lots 1, 2, 2, and 4 dedicated for right-of-way purposes pursuant to document R87-89017, in DuPage County, Illinois.


