

RESOLUTION R-42-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF  
SBC SERVICE AGREEMENTS/DS1 LEASED LINES  
WATER DIVISION/FIRE STATIONS ONE, TWO AND THREE

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois ("City") is an Illinois Home Rule municipality pursuant to provisions of Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this resolution pertains to the government and affairs of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to provide high-speed and reliable network capabilities to four remote City-owned locations, including the City's Water Division (210 Reber Street), Fire Station One (One Fapp Circle), Fire Station Two (1590 S. President Street), and Fire Station Three (1700 N. Main Street); and

WHEREAS, the City staff completed an analysis of networking options, including wireless solutions, and determined that the most cost-effective solution to meet the City's current networking needs is to lease traditional DS1 lines from SBC; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to enter into agreements with SBC for DS1 services at the City's remote locations including the City's Water Division, Fire Station One, Fire Station Two, and Fire Station Three.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign, and the City Clerk is authorized to attest, SBC Custom DS1 Service Agreements, sixty-month term plans, dated June 6, 2005, between the City of Wheaton and SBC Local Services, Inc.
